Word Press: Backing Up Your site

Reasons for backing up:

- Your host might have technical problems destroying your site and your backups.
- Your site and backups might get hacked.
- Your hosting provider may be bought or go out of business.

What to backup and when:

- Wordpress should be backed up, once a month or less.
- Themes and plugins, once a month and any time changes are made.
- **Databases** should be weekly, daily, or hourly depending on usage.
- Uploads should be weekly, daily, or hourly depending on usage.

Manually Backing up your site:

Backup the Database:

- Go to phpmyadmin of your webserver.
- Go to export.
- You can customize , which table you want.
- After selecting , export them in a zipped form.
- In "object creation option", "add create database/use statement" should be unchecked, otherwise you will have problem in importing that database.
- Download.

Restore the database from a backup:

- Go to phpmyadmin.
- Click on import.
- Upload that database, you backed up.

Back up WordPress files:

Wp-content has all uploads, themes and plugins so it should be backup.

.htaccess communicate with web server. It should be backed-up.

- Setup a ftp account.
- Select all the files.
- Download them in your computer through ftp.

Restore wordpress files from backup:

Through ftp/sftp you can upload to the webserver.

Host-Managed backup services:

Most reputed servers, give you backup options.

Depending on your hosting plan, It can be a one click solution too.

Create a backup:

You can create backup in your webserver at any time.

Backup using third party plugins:

There are many backup plugins in wordpress plugin directory.

You can select from third party plugins too.

Updraftplus.com has both free and premium version of backup plugins.

Check the features, according to your requirements.

- Install and activate updraft plus.
- Go to settings-->updraftplus Backups-->now you will see different option of backup.

Configure and schedule backups:

- Settings-->updraft plus backups-->Settings-->files backup schedule-->and retain this may schedule backups for 14(recommended) days.
- Choose your remote storage location e.g dropbox etc.
- Authenticate with dropbox.

- Complete setup.
- You can choose/customize, what you want to backup and what not.
- Save changes.

Restore your site from backup:

- Go to your dropbox and you can see different versions of backups.
- In wordpress, in the backup option, click restore.
- Don't close the window, until the process completes.

Backup using site migration plugin:

Backing and migrating are closely related, that's why many backup plugins, now offer migrating too.

For this tutorial, instructor used duplicator pro, which needs purchasing.

- Go to settings-->DuplicatorPro-->storage
- Name your storage e.g dropbox.
- Use type e.g dropbox
- Connect to dropbox
- Authorize.
- You will get a code, copy it.
- Paste this code in setup.

Now, you can schedule backup.

- Under duplicator pro, go to schedules
- Name it e.g main backup.
- You can choose your default storage e.g dropbox.
- Then schedule repeats that after how many days you want backingup.
- Enable this schedule.
- Save schedule.
- A full package would be created for backup.

Create a manual package:

- Go to duplicator pro under settings
- Click on create new
- Choose the default template.
- Store it in dropbox.
- Under archive, tell which files you want.
- Click next
- Click on build.
- You can download the package, which is now your backup.

Restore your site from package:

Now you have backups in dropbox.

- Download backup in your computer from dropbox.
- Extract them.
- You will get 2 files archive and installer.
- Rename the name of installer to installer.php.
- Now do ftp for these 2 files.
- Drag them to the root folder of your site.
- Once, they have transferred, go to url yourwebsite/installer.php
- This brings the duplicator pro installer.
- Check the terms to accept them.
- Press next.
- Press apply.
- Test database.
- You would see many options which you can change here, like title, url etc. If you want to change.
- Click next
- Now you have a new, migrated site.
